Please note the following important points of information:

- All pupils must be accompanied by a parent/guardian for the Walk.
- If you are bringing your dog on the Walk, please make sure s/he is on a lead at all times.
- Please bear in mind that there are **NO** traffic restrictions yet in place at weekends in the Phoenix Park. Chesterfield Avenue will be fully open to traffic. Cars can be parked on Chesterfield Avenue or Furze Road.....this is the second right turn off Chesterfield Avenue when entering the Phoenix Park via the Castleknock Gate.
Starting point for the Walk is on Furze Road (see map).
- After the Walk all participants will gather in the nearby picnic area for treats and drinks.

IMPORTANT: Pupils are asked to return Walk Sponsorship Cards and money to the school by **Thursday 3rd May.** We thank you for your continued support for this annual event. If you are unable to participate in this year's Walk, we would appreciate it if you would still consider making a donation to the walk fund. All monies raised will go towards the upgrade of the school's outdoor facilities. Reminder: pupils are not allowed to go door-to-door with walk cards looking for sponsorship.
